Overview

- This was United Biscuits first volunteering challenge in the local community. Over 40 volunteers took part
- School caters for nearly 70 students who have emotional and behavioural difficulties and provides support and encouragement to overcoming barriers and succeeding in life
- Tasks included creating a vegetable allotment, repainting the entire school hall and a large school block, and creating a sports themed mural, all in a day's work!
- Vegetable allotment used to prepare healthy, organic meals for the students
